

Welcome To Agur Lake Camp

We have one large generator to supply the cabins, the Adam trailer and the RV with electricity. To save on fuel and maintenance expense, which are costly up here in the wilderness, we would like to recommend the following hours to run our main generator unless there are guests who require and electrical hookup for breathing or medical requirements. We can also supply a small portable generator for medical equipment.

The main generator will operate at the following hours:

Start up at 6:00 am

Shut down at 9:30 am

Start up at 11:00 am

Shut down at 2:00 pm

Start up at 4:30 pm

Shut down at 9:00pm

After the generator is shut down at the various indicated hours above, there is still hot water available for limited use (suggest not to shower during this time) and limited use of toilets. If there is a special circumstance existing, please contact our Onsite Supervisors.

We will supply each cabin and/or group with a walkie-talkie—direct communication with our Onsite Supervisors. In an emergency at night, our Onsite Supervisors will be staying in the 5th wheel between the Adam trailer and the pump house.

We have limited golf cart access in case a guest cannot use their wheelchair to access fishing or the trails. Please speak to our Onsite Supervisors about access.

If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to speak with our Onsite Supervisors on the walkie-talkie and they will arrange to meet with you ASAP.

What is good, what is not and what could be changed, etc. We are thankful for any and all suggestions to help guide us on this wonderful adventure towards an awesome barrier free camp for special needs children, adult, their families and/or their caregivers.
